

LIVE COMMUNITY EVENT PRESENTATION

Recommended Audience: The community members, parents, friends, and relatives of students that participated in a Rachel's Challenge assembly program earlier in the day or week. Not recommended for children under 6th grade. You may choose to show the Elementary "Link Up!" Presentation in the evening in lieu of the "Community Event" themed presentation.

Prerequisite: None, but done in conjunction with an elementary, middle school or high school program earlier in the day or week.

Logistics: A 60-minute assembly delivered by one certified Rachel's Challenge presenter at your site.

Program Description: The Community Event introduces Rachel and her story to parents and community members using stories from her life and writings. This event is typically held in the evening. It is similar in content and intensity to the Rachel's Challenge high school program. The Community Event shows the profound positive impact we have on those around us. It demonstrates to the listener the power of deliberately reaching out to others to start what Rachel called a chain reaction of kindness and compassion. The Community Event encourages participants to examine their own lives in the light of the following 5 challenges.

Challenges:

1. Look for the Best in Others
2. Dream Big
3. Choose Positive Influences
4. Speak with Kindness
5. Start your own Chain Reaction
